

*Incarceration

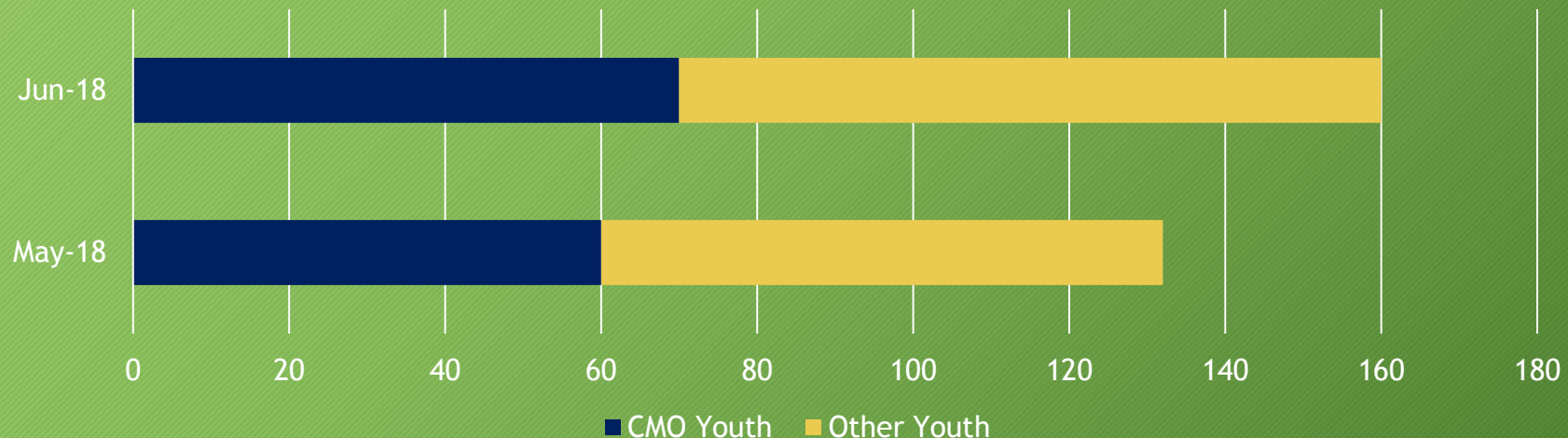

LET'S LOOK AT THE NUMBERS, 12345

- In May (2018) 60 (Blue) (of 132) court hearings were for CMO youth. 45%
- In June (2018) 70 (Blue) (of 160) court hearings were for CMO youth. 43%
- # of youth court/probation involved: 108
- # of court involved youth in OOH: 41

WHAT ROLE DO YOU PLAY IN COURT/FCIU...

When working with a youth who has legal involvement some of the expectations of providers may include:

- Documentation that is shared in proceedings, used for planning, etc.
- Face to Face work at institutional settings - i.e. Shelter, Juvenile Jail
- Transitional work with families during the community reintegration stage
- On going communication with all CFT members
- Discharge or transitioning your services based on the youths legal status and ability to receive Wraparound services
- Role of the CFC System Coordinator

WHAT ROLE DO YOU PLAY IN COURT/FCIU...

- How does a petition for FCIU work?
 - *How can you assist during this period of time and what should you steer clear from?
 - *What happens to the services you provide to the youth and family during this time?
 - *Examples of how NJ has made progression with regards to juveniles and the court system...
 - *How can you remain a supportive team member when the youth is no longer in the home due to legal issues?

What is The Nurtured Heart Approach? It is a relationship methodology founded strategically in "the 3 stands" for helping children and adults build their inner wealth.

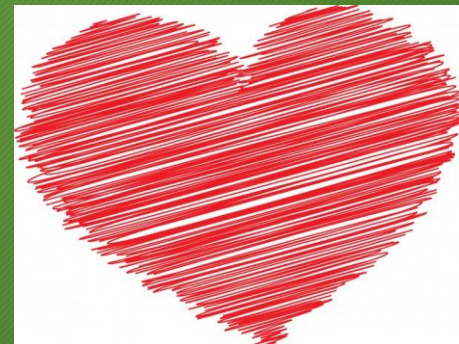
- What are "the 3 stands"?
